***If you are a parent or staff struggling with “out of control” challenging behaviors, this training series is for you! This four part Crisis Management training will cover:***

**Crisis Prevention:** The best way to handle a crisis situation is to prevent it **BEFORE** it happens! Learn a wide range of nonphysical and verbal strategies for the prevention of crisis situations.

**Crisis De-escalation:** Learn strategies for verbally de-escalating disruptive and aggressive behaviors. Participants will be taught to quickly and safely stabilize an escalating situation before it becomes necessary to physically intervene.

**Crisis Intervention:** Learn personal safety skills to keep yourself and others safe when a crisis situation occurs.

**Post Crisis Intervention:** Gain the skills necessary to effectively interact following a crisis and identify how to improve future interaction to prevent and manage future crises.
